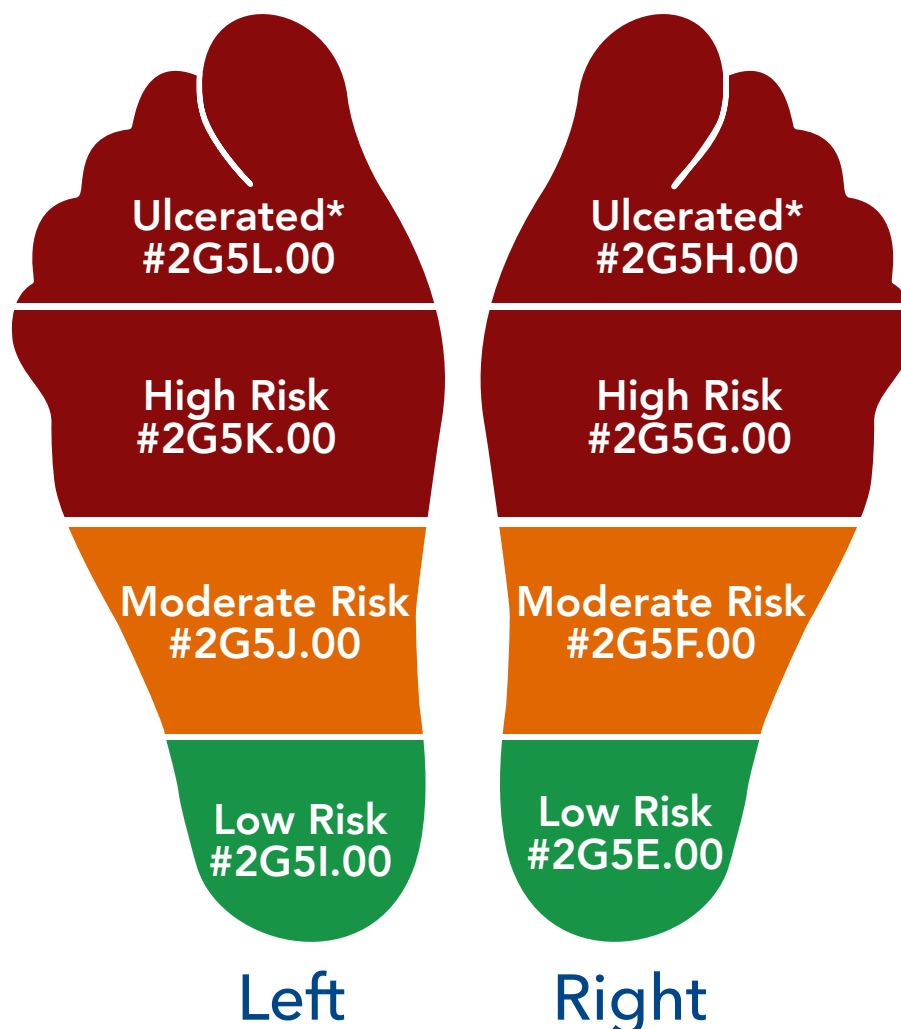


Coding for Diabetes foot screening



Low Risk

No risk factors present

At least one pedal pulse palpable
AND normal sensation
AND no structural abnormality
in foot/callus.

Moderate Risk

One risk factor present

Both pulses absent
OR abnormal sensation
OR structural abnormality
in foot /callus.

High Risk

More than one risk factor

Both pulses absent
AND/OR abnormal sensation
AND/OR structural abnormality
in foot/callus

Or in remission e.g. previous
ulceration, amputation or Charcot.

Screen every 2 years

Screen annually
One-off appt with podiatry

No screening - should be
under NHS podiatry review
