On recent assessments, and overnight, Martha has been struggling with pain from her hip. Martha has Type 2 Diabetes. She has diabetic foot ulcers. Since her admission, she has been having frequent episodes of hypoglycaemia.



Gregory Lestrade

Gregory has just arrived on the ward. He has recently had a Hospital Acquired Pneumonia for which he is on treatment with oral antibiotics. He has been receiving Chest Physiotherapy input on the other ward. On arrival on the ward, his observations have been taken and he has a NEWS of 10 due to low saturations, high respiratory rate, and a fast pulse
